Dear TAFE Colleges

Mary Franklin is currently the AEU/SSTUWA General Secretary and has held that position for 7 years. I am a lecturer at SAH college of TAFE and a member of the AEU/SSTUWA Executive Committee and the long-serving team which recently secured a new agreement for TAFE lecturers.

Our work ensures that we are both up to date with the current issues concerning TAFE.

TAFE is a vital public education institution which is critically important to Western Australia industry and the broader community. The job we do as TAFE lecturers ensures the provision of skills and training for thousands of workers across the state.

We have always understood TAFE to be about providing industry training, further education, second chance education, re-training options for those re-entering the workforce, education pathways for migrants and English as a second language, as well as for students seeking alternative year 11/12 school programs.

This view of TAFE has been under serious attack through funding cuts as state and federal governments attempt to diverge their responsibilities for the provision of a quality TAFE system, despite the demands for increased industry skills.

Our union must continue to drive the broader TAFE funding campaign to stop further erosion of state and federal funding.

TAFE members need a senior officer team with a General Secretary who will provide leadership and support to:

- build union membership through a properly resourced TAFE recruitment plan
- build union strength through campus level collective actions
- campaign statewide on the key TAFE issues in all TAFE colleges:
 - workload
 - accountability, IT and auditing requirements
 - mismanagement of behaviour and practices which breach WPS legislation
 - increased organisational bullying as compliance requirements become stricter
